ACTION STEPS

1. 1. What mistakes have you made in the past that are holding you back from pursuing God's calling for your life? What negative memories continually invade your thoughts and bring hopelessness and discouragement?
 - Get alone somewhere, take out a piece of paper, and write them down.
 - Destroy the paper! Rip it up, burn it, completely destroy its physical existence.
 - As soon as the paper is destroyed, take control in the spirit. Speak—out loud—Philippians 3:13–14 (Amp): "Brothers and sisters, I do not consider that I have made it my own yet; but one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the [heavenly] prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus."
2. Get a vision for your relationship with God.
 - Write down two or three goals that you can start pursuing right now to get closer to God. This could be anything like joining a church or small group, doing a bible study, volunteering for some mission work, serving on a prayer line, doing daily devotionals, etc.
 - Commit to pursuing these goals and daily journal your progress.
