# LEADERSHIP HONOUR CODE

As an essential part of the Christian Family Church International Leadership family, you have a responsibility to develop and exhibit mature Christian behaviour. This should be the basic premise of your desire to participate in a servant-leader position here at Christian Family Church International.

While serving the Body of Christ as a servant-leader at Christian Family Church International, you pledge to present a good appearance at all times. In both attire and behaviour, you should strive to demonstrate Biblical standards in all situations.

As Christians, the way we present ourselves to others is of vital importance to the way others perceive Christ. Our conduct should never be an embarrassment to Christ but should exemplify the best qualities of a mature believer and servant-leader.

Exemplifying the highest moral commitment, Christian Family Church International leaders are to maintain a disciplined life of Bible reading, prayer, and fasting.

You must also refrain from such things as:

- Profanity.
- Smoking or chewing tobacco.
- Gambling.
- Indulging in much wine or other alcoholic beverages.
- Dishonest gain.
- Illicit drugs.
- Pornography.
- Sexual immorality:
- Fornication is sex before marriage.
- Adultery is sex outside of marriage.
- All behaviours which might cause Christ to grieve and others to stumble.

By providing an example in speech and action, we encourage others to grow in Christ and become servant-leaders themselves. This is a way of life measured by the heart and commitment of each leader in the Christian Family Church International family. We should regard it as an essential part of our development, not as an imposition or restriction.
